Once I create the book and finalize it, the companies print and bind it in their factory. In about a week I have a professional book with my subtitles, and pictures.

This is definitely a unique gift, a great way to store your photos and easy to do. There are many websites that create these books. The easiest is My Publisher. I believe Sony has the best quality.
